

## Darlene Koldenhoven Bio Highlights

**Darlene Koldenhoven** is a **GRAMMY® Award Winner** with 3 GRAMMY® nominations. She is a vocalist, keyboardist/pianist, composer, songwriter, arranger, lyricist, producer, credentialed voice teacher, and certified sonic therapist. Darlene is known worldwide as the featured soprano soloist singing “Aria” in the PBS TV Special and Video, *Yanni, Live at the Acropolis* seen by over 1.5 billion television viewers and millions more now on YouTube, and most notably, as the tambourine-waving choir nun with **Whoopi Goldberg** in both *Sister Act* films where off-camera she was the production vocal coach and vocal contractor, music director and rehearsal pianist during their choreography rehearsal. The Los Angeles Chapter of The Recording Academy presented Darlene with an **MVP Best Session Singer** for singing with her 5-octave range on over 1,000 recordings in films, television, records, commercials, and charitable causes internationally. You’ll find her name on the vocal credits of a plethora of artists’ albums, including **Pink Floyd, Barbra Streisand, Whitney Houston, Neil Young, Celine Dion, Rod Stewart, Kenny Loggins, Ringo Starr**, and as a lead soprano for **Clare Fischer’s 2+2**, the source of her GRAMMY® Award and 3 nominations in Best Jazz Vocal Performance by Group. Darlene has also performed as a soloist with **David Byrne** at the **Royal Albert Hall** with London’s **Royal Philharmonic**; the **Chicago Symphony**; on the **Academy Awards®** with the late **Robin Williams, Paul McCartney** at the Hollywood Bowl, and **Ricky Kej** at the Queen’s Palace in Bangalore, India. As a solo indie artist, Darlene is the first inductee into the **IMC’s Indie Music Hall of Fame** presented at the GRAMMY Museum.® She has an **Outstanding Legacy Award** and **Hall of Fame induction** from The Akademia; **Lifetime Achievement Award** and **Hall of Fame induction** from One World Music Radio; and **Outstanding Artist 2023** from New Age Music Planet Gran Prix Awards.

Darlene has written her memoir, **Put Your Dress Down and Sing** (Sibylline Press), and a companion solo piano album of her original compositions titled **A Grand Memoir** (TimeArt®). The book, e-book, audiobook, album, and album songbook will be released on 8/7/26. Music from the album appears throughout her audiobook.

Her previous two solo piano albums, **The Grand Piano Spa** (5/14/21) and **The Grand Piano Spa: Legacy** (10/22/21), ranked a Hot Shot Debut at **#4** on **Billboard’s Classical Crossover Albums Chart** (week of May 29, 2021) and at **#8** on the same chart in November later that year, both the first week the albums came out.

Darlene’s label, TimeArt® Recordings, now has fourteen of her albums and several singles which are heard all over the world, including on **SiriusXM, Pandora, Spotify, Tidal, Apple Music, Amazon Music, YouTube, SoundCloud, Music Choice**, and hundreds more worldwide radio stations. Her instrumental albums are played in treatment rooms of massage, yoga, and healing practitioners and are on rotation on the **CARE Channel Network** in hospitals and hospices worldwide. Even Olympic athletes like Olympic Silver Medalist and US Champion Figure Skater Sasha Cohen perform to her music.

She has many awards for her vocal and piano New Age/Classical Crossover albums, including several “Best of” albums. Many have debuted #1 on the ZMR International Radio Charts, as well as debuted at #1 on Australia’s SoundsLikeCafe Radio Charts & Norway’s New Age Music Guide Radio Charts (11/22), and more.

Born and raised in Chicago, Darlene’s formal piano training, which began at age 9, made the piano her closest friend. Despite losing the use of her right hand for five years due to a horrible accident twenty-eight years ago, which even after reconstructive surgery left one finger deformed, she forged on, regaining most of her piano prowess. She now performs her elegant solo piano concerts with her newest albums.

Darlene reads music and improvises, playing many styles – Classical, New Age, Jazz, Rock, Pop, Musical Theater. She accompanies herself on piano or keytar-synth in her live vocal concerts; plays harpsichord and piano with

orchestras; and, on synth and vocals, she has accompanied other vocalists or instrumentalists on their live concert tours.

Ms. Koldenhoven holds a Master's degree in voice and a Bachelor's in Music Education from Chicago Conservatory College and has authored an educational book with 7 instructional CDs & downloads titled, ***Tune Your Voice: Singing and Your Mind's Musical Ear***, endorsed by faculty from Juilliard, American Idol, Berklee, and NYU. She is a credentialed voice teacher and certified Integrated Listening Systems sonic therapist who helps people overcome dis-ease by using her therapeutic music and unique listening techniques in her private practice, as well as her healing music concerts and workshops, internationally.
